

Policy for Submitting Articles

Articles submitted for publication must adhere to the following policy:

1. BIBLE VERSIONS

Use only the *King James Version* or the *American Standard Version* in all articles.

It is imperative that one use a literal translation for the basic text and all other books called Bibles for comparison and commentary only. Apart from interlinear versions (which are absolutely word-for-word translations), the consensus of scholarship rates the KJV and the ASV as the most literal versions among those of practical usage (Dub McClish, "The Right And Wrong Uses Of Paraphrases," *A Handbook on Bible Translation The Ninth Annual Shenandoah Lectures*, 1995, Terry Hightower, ed., p. 958).

2. TYPEFACE

Use Georgia 13 point typeface.

3. SENTENCES

Do not double space between sentences.

4. PARAGRAPHS

Do not indent paragraphs; double space between them (See a copy of *TGP* as example).

5. EMPHASIS

Use **boldface type**, not italics to emphasize words.

6. QUOTES

Use quotation marks for quotes less than four lines. For four or more lines, set off quotes in double indent and do not use quotation marks.

7. TITLES

Place book and periodical titles in *italics*.

8. LENGTH

One to three 8 ½ x 11 pages is a good length.

9. SUBMISSION FORMAT

Submit articles in docx format.

No article will be considered that does not meet these guidelines.
